Lamp post charging: the innovative approach by ubitricity

ubitricity has developed a compact charging solution by integrating charging facilities into urban lamp posts. This inexpensive solution enables nationwide establishments of charging infrastructures.

In the UK, ubitricity is the provider with the most public charging points. The Berlin-based company also launched a standard-compliant lamp post charge point for Germany in October 2021.

The lamp post charge points from ubitricity enable drivers without a private parking space to charge their EV easily with a standard type 2 cable in the immediate surrounding of their home. Cities benefit from the use of existing infrastructure and the associated short planning times, low investment costs and high scalability.

With the growing need for smart grids in mind, the ubitricity charging solution, with its longer connection times, forms the basis for making an e-vehicle available to the energy grid as intelligent storage - an essential building block for the energy transition.
